

1 in 5 Kentucky bachelor's degrees

8,000 degrees & credentials annually

4 years the average time it takes to complete a degree. 3 out of 4 first-time, fulltime students who graduate from the private college where they started do so in 4 years. (The sector graduation rate is 50%, with colleges ranging from around 30% to 85%.)

99% of first-time full-time students receive grants and scholarships (86% of all undergraduates do).

\$285 million in grants and scholarships are *provided by the institutions* themselves each year

43% of all undergraduates receive Pell Grants (family incomes <\$40,000). 50% of firsttime full-time students qualify for Pell.

10,000 Kentucky residents rely on the \$27 million in Kentucky Tuition Grants (KTG) awarded to AIKCU students.

\$5,714 Kentucky's investment in Kentucky Tuition Grants per bachelor's degree

\$700 million annual economic impact in Kentucky
